Contract Agreement: Students

This Agreement lays out the expectations of Bluewater Adventures & Crew in efforts to provide you & your school group with the most beneficial and impactful experience possible. Compliance of all participants is expected.

Participant Agreement:

- SV Island Odyssey, SV Island Roamer and SV Island Solitude are beautiful yachts that – abuse of the boats in any way will not be tolerated. Any repairs will be the responsibility of the person doing the damage and of their school.
- No junk food or gum is permitted on the vessels. Peanuts in any form are not permitted due to allergies. Consumption of alcohol, combustibles, vapes, cannabis or illegal drugs will not be permitted onboard. Should any prohibited items be found, they will be confiscated. Student/s may be asked to leave vessel.
- Be mindful of cell phone use. Bluewater Crew want you/ students to be in the moment and participating in activities.
- Make-up, hair dryers, straighteners/ curling irons are unnecessary while on board. Electricity is not available in the cabins most of the time. Chargers for camera batteries are permitted with a charging station supplied in the salon.
- Bluewater Crew members will ask for all participants to be mindful of water usage due to the ships supply capabilities and shower-taking must be limited. There will be plenty of drinking water provided.
- Life-jackets must be worn at all times in the zodiacs, kayaks and at the discretion of Bluewater Crew. Individual School Boards may have additional requirements.
- It is your responsibility to clean up after yourself, keep you cabin tidy and complete assigned tasks.
- There will be set time for lights out which must be respected.
- Only those assigned to cabins should be in those cabins.
- Be prepared to listen and follow instructions.

As a Student:

1. I agree to be attentive, ready to help, learn and participate fully in all the operations of the boat,
2. From navigation to sailing, cleaning, dishes, and/or cooking. To help in any way necessary when asked by crew of the Island Odyssey, Island Roamer, Island Solitude, teacher or adult supervisor.
3. I have read and understood the "PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT" and agree that I will comply fully with all rules.
4. I understand that anything I bring to the boat that is not permitted will be confiscated and may be disposed of.
5. If I exhibit behaviour that is disrespectful or hurtful to the crew, chaperones, my peers or to my surroundings, the Captain will intervene. If negative behaviour continues, I understand I may be asked to leave the trip at the expense of my parent/guardian.
