## 2025 FEATURE DONATION

### THE WHALE INTERPRETIVE CENTRE (JOHNSTONE STRAIT KILLER WHALE INTERPRETIVE CENTRE SOCIETY)

The Whale Interpretive Centre in Telegraph Cove first opened in 2002 with the mission to increase public education about the biology of marine mammals and threats facing their population in British Columbia. Sadly, on the morning of December 31, 2024, Telegraph Cove suffered a devastating fire, and, despite the efforts of responders, the museum and its impressive collection of marine mammal skeletons did not survive. During the summer of 2025, their passionate team continued to educate visitors to the Johnstone Strait area in "the Whale Shed" with specimens that were off-site at the time of the fire (including three cetacean skeletons). The WIC continues to rebuild and looks forward to reopening soon.
